

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL  
**February 26, 2019**

The Marceline City Council met in regular session on February 26, 2019 at 5:45 p.m. at the Marceline Public Safety Building (Fire Barn), Mayor Tyson Brammer presiding. Council members present were Jeri Holt, Sallie Buck, and Liz Cupp. Councilwoman Natalie Wellman were absent. Mayor Tyson Brammer led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order at 5:45 pm.

**DOWNTOWN MARCELINE PICNIC LICENSES – ST PATRICK’S DAY EVENT & WELCOME HOME ALUMNI EVENT:** City Clerk Krumpelman explained that the picnic licenses are for events hosted by Downtown Marceline to be held in their new Ballroom space, which used to be the youth center. The first event is before their regular March Council meeting, which a special meeting was requested. City Manager Richard Hoon reported the events are fundraisers for continued improvements to the Ballroom space. The Council discussed the topic. Councilwoman Buck moved to approve the temporary sale by the drink (picnic license) licenses for the Downtown Marceline St. Patrick Day’s Event on March 16, 2019 and the Downtown Marceline Welcome Home Alumni Event on May 11, 2019. Councilman Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried.
