

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
February 28, 2017

The Marceline City Council met in special session on February 28, 2017 at 10:15 a.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Jeri Holt presiding. Council members present were: Sallie Buck, John Carver, and Natalie Wellman. Councilman Tyson Brammer was absent. Staff attending: City Manager Robert V. Green and City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman. Mayor Jeri Holt called the meeting to order at 10:15 am.
