

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
June 01, 2016

The Marceline City Council met in special session on June 1, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Jeri Holt presiding. Council members present were: John Carver, Sallie Buck, Natalie Wellman, and Tyson Brammer. Staff attending: City Attorney Jeff Elson, City Manager Robert V. Green, City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman, Electric Superintendent Dean Gauthier, and Water/Wastewater Superintendent Kevin Wiggins. Others Present: Cary Sayre and Bob Harbour.

Mayor Jeri Holt called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm.

Councilwoman Buck moved to adjourn to Executive Session pursuant to RSMo 610.21 Paragraph (12) Contracts. Councilwoman Wellman seconded the motion. The following roll call vote carried the motion: Councilwoman Buck — yes, Councilwoman Wellman — yes, Councilman Brammer — yes, Councilman Carver — yes, and Mayor Holt — yes.

Upon returning from executive session at 4:30 pm, Councilman Carver moved that the signatures for lease payments for the fire truck be changed to Mayor Jeri Holt, City Manager Robert V. Green, and City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman. Councilman Brammer seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Utility Rate Study: City Clerk Krumpelman reported on her research with the Council. Cary Sayre went over the matrixes for the Water and Wastewater portions of utility rate study with those present. Bob Harbour presented on the options for the Electric portion of the utility rate study to the Council.

With no further business, Councilman Brammer moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilwoman Wellman seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 6:33 pm.
