

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
July 17, 2018

The Marceline City Council met in a work session on July 17, 2018 members present were: Jeri Holt, Sallie Buck, and Liz Cupp. Councilwoman Natalie Wellman was absent. Staff attending: City Manager Richard Hoon, City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman, and Street Superintendent Ed Ewigman. Recreation & Park Board Members present: Cary Sayre, Richard Switzer, Charles Jobson, Maxine Smith, and Nickie Wrenn. Alpha Nu Beta Members present: Molly Cupp and Courtney Schreiner.

Mayor Tyson Brammer called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm.

Concession Stand: City Manager Hoon stated the purpose of the work session is to discuss the replacement of the Concession Stand in Ripley Park. He provided a project description and a timeline. Recreation and Park President Charles Jobson stated the project estimate he provided is for a bigger building and a new rendition should be less. Those present discussed the project including the timeline, cost estimate, the option of volunteer labor, the necessity of a rendering of the building and funding options. Council asked Cary Sayre his opinion. He responded that public use facilities need to be engineered / designed per state statutes and he cannot do it as he does not engineer those types of facilities. There was further discussion on the topic.

At 5:22 pm Councilman Holt moved to adjourn. Councilwoman Buck seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
