

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
September 2, 2015

The Marceline City Council met in special session on September 2, 2015 at 9:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Josh Shoemaker presiding. Council members present were: Jeri Holt, John Carver, and Sallie Buck. Councilman Tyson Brammer was absent. Staff attending: City Manager Richard Hoon, City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman and Electric Superintendent Dean Gauthier.

****This meeting was called with less than 24 hours notice due to the nature of the topic and the necessity of the Council to discuss it as soon as possible.****

Mayor Josh Shoemaker called the meeting to order at 9:00 p.m.

Power Outage: Mayor Shoemaker stated the emergency meeting is called due to the scheduling of the power outage due to complete the repair needed on the transmission line. City Manager Hoon explained the background of the issue, starting with the flicker last week. He noted that if the City does not fix the issue as soon as possible that the City could be without power for three days if that line goes down. Electric Superintendent Dean Gauthier further expanded on the issue, reporting that Ameren has to be present to complete the repair. City Manager Hoon explained the original time of 10:00 am - 12:00 pm on Friday, September 4th was scheduled after Superintendent Gauthier had spoken with Ameren at the issue. The assembly discussed changing the scheduled time to a more convenient time for local businesses than at 10:00 am and the issues surrounding it. Superintendent Dean Gauthier and City Manager Hoon were asked to get with Ameren to re-schedule the power outage for Friday at 5:00pm or Saturday.

Councilman Holt moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Carver seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 9:38 pm.
