

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL  
**September 12, 2019**

The Marceline City Council met for a special session on September 12, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Sallie Buck presiding. Council members present were Jeri Holt, Tyson Brammer, Liz Cupp, and Lacey Meissen. Staff attending: City Manager Richard Hoon and City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman. Others Present: none.

Mayor Sallie Buck led those present in the Pledged of Allegiance and called the special session to order at 1:00 pm.

Councilman Holt moved to add the item of *September Council Meeting Change* to the Agenda. Councilman Brammer seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Ripley Park: Mayor Buck reported this meeting was called due to information that the Council needs to be aware of concerning Ripley Park. City Manager Hoon provided background on the topic. He reported that during a search for a copy of the deed containing the alcohol restrictions in Ripley Park that was requested, an abstract was found in a Walt Disney Park file that looked like it could have a potential effect of those restrictions. City Manager Hoon stated the abstract was provided to the City Attorney to provide an opinion and to assist in completing the records request. City Manager Hoon reported that based on the City Attorney's investigation into the matter, the legal opinion is that it appears those restrictions are no longer effective and that if the Council wishes to prohibit the sale or distribution of intoxicating liquor in Ripley Park, than it would need to be addressed by Municipal Ordinance. The Council discussed the information presented. City Manager Hoon stated this item will be on the agenda next week to continue the discussion on how to proceed on this topic.

September Council Meeting Change: The Council discussed options to move next week's regularly scheduled meeting due to the scheduling conflicts of Council members. The budget work sessions and the October meeting dates will be discussed at the next meeting. Councilman Brammer moved to change the regular meeting to Wednesday, September 18, 2019 at 6:00 pm. Councilwoman Cupp seconded the motion.

With no further business, Councilman Brammer moved to adjourn the special session. Councilwoman Meissen seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously, and the meeting was adjourned at 1:54 pm.
