

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
September 29, 2016

The Marceline City Council met in special session on September 29, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Jeri Holt presiding. Council members present were: Sallie Buck, John Carver, Natalie Wellman, and Tyson Brammer. Staff attending: City Manager Robert V. "Bob" Green, City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman, Street Superintendent Ed Ewigman, Police Chief Bob Donelson, Electric Superintendent Dean Gauthier, and Water/Wastewater Superintendent Kevin Wiggins.

Mayor Jeri Holt called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

Bill No. 16-09.039 Budget Amendment - Street Sweeper: Street Superintendent Ed Ewigman discussed the Street Sweeper with the Council which the City paid \$5,000.00 to place a hold one earlier in the year. There was some discussion on the topic. Councilman Carver moved to introduce Bill No. 16-09.039 for the first reading. Councilwoman Buck seconded the motion. The motion carried. City Clerk Krumpelman read the bill by title only. Councilman Carver moved that Bill No. 16-09.039 be read for a second and final time by title only. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Buck. The motion carried. City Clerk Krumpelman read the bill a second time by title only. Councilman Carver moved Bill No. 16-09.039 be approved. Councilwoman Wellman seconded the motion. The following roll call vote carried the motion: Councilman Carver – yes, Councilwoman Buck – yes, Councilwoman Wellman – yes, Councilman Brammer – yes, and Mayor Holt – yes. This bill was assigned Ordinance Number 16-09.38.

Street Closure Request - Day to Dream: City Manager Bob Green reported on the 'Disney Day to Dream' Event scheduled for Monday, October 17th and the Walt Disney Hometown Museum is requesting California Avenue be closed in front of the Marceline Carnegie Library. Council discussed the request with Councilman Brammer stating for the safety of the kids he would like to expand the street closure for the entire street. Councilman Brammer moved to close California from Santa Fe Ave to no name road for 'Disney Day to Dream' on Monday, October 17th from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Councilwoman Wellman seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Street Closure Request - District Softball: Street Superintendent Ed Ewigman reported to the Council that Marceline will be hosting the District Softball Tournament from Wednesday to Saturday and the school is requesting the Wells Street be closed from Kansas to Mulberry for those games. Councilman Brammer moved to close Wells Street from Kansas to Mulberry on Wednesday, October 5th through Saturday, October 8th, from 3:00 pm to the end of the games. Councilman Carver seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Budget Work Session: Council and City Staff discussed the draft budget. Another work session will be scheduled to balance the budget before the October Regular Council meeting. A work session for the Utility Rate Study will be scheduled as well.

With no further business, Councilman Brammer moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Carver seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 8:57 pm.
