

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
October 3, 2017

The Marceline City Council met in special session on October 3, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Jeri Holt presiding. Council members present were: Tyson Brammer, Sallie Buck, Natalie Wellman, and Liz Cupp. Staff attending: City Manager Richard Hoon, City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman, Water/Wastewater Superintendent Roger Sullivan and Lineman Todd Field. Also in attendance were: Jason Weydert, Joe Rogers, Tim Schade, Jacob Waidmann, Dave Kennon, Dan Cothorn, and Christopher Herndon.

Mayor Pro-Tem Tyson Brammer led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Mayor Jeri Holt joined the meeting immediately following

Health Insurance: Jason Weydert stated that at the last meeting he had informed the Council the City's current health insurance provider, United Health Care (UHC), renewal included a 19.7% increase. He provided the Council with three options. Lifestyle Show-Me Benefits is a partial self-funded plan with the HSA benefit and would give the City a \$5,000.00/month savings compared to the UHC renewal. He reported City of Brookfield and Smith Motors are with Lifestyle now. Councilwoman Buck inquired if the plan was comparable to the City's current one. Jason Weydert stated it was, except the network is not as good as UHC, but then no one is. He did state he just received the numbers from Lifestyle so he has not spoken to UHC about negotiating the rates. The Council discussed the topic. Council requested the topic be put on Thursday's meeting after Jason Weydert is able to speak with United Health Care.

Councilwoman Wellman moved to adjourn to Executive Session pursuant to RSMo 610.021 Paragraph (12) Contracts and to include guests Water/Wastewater Superintendent Roger Sullivan, Lineman Todd Field, Joe Rogers, Tim Schade, Jacob Waidmann, Dave Kennon, Dan Cothorn, and Christopher Herndon. Councilman Brammer seconded the motion. The following roll call vote carried the motion unanimously: Councilwoman Wellman – aye, Councilman Brammer – aye, Mayor Holt – aye, Councilwoman Cupp – aye, and Councilwoman Buck – aye.

At 8:31, Council returned from Executive Session and briefly discussed a meeting time for a special session on October 12th to meet with Cary Sayre on the Facility Plan. Council provided a consensus to meet at 12:00 pm on October 12th for a special meeting concerning the Facility Plan. Councilman Brammer moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilwoman Wellman seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 8:39 pm.
