

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
October 5, 2020**

The Marceline City Council met in special session on October 5, 2020 at 1:07 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Sallie Buck presiding. Council members present were Tyson Brammer and Gary Carlson. Councilman Jeri Holt and Councilwoman Lacey Brammer were absent. Staff attending: City Manager Richard Hoon and City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman. Others Present: none.

Mayor Sallie Buck led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order 1:07 pm (Delay in start time due to the wait for a quorum to be present).

Marceline R-V – District Softball Street Closure Request: City Manager Hoon explained the street closure request from Coach Ross from Marceline R-V School for the District Softball Tournament. He stated the intersections for the closures will serve as paid entry gates per MSHSAA requirements. The Council discussed the topic. Councilman Brammer moved to approve the closure of the following: Wells Street from Kansas Avenue to Mulberry Street, Chestnut Street from Curtis Street to Wells Street, Mulberry Street from Wells Street to Centennial Drive, Centennial Drive from Kansas Avenue to Mulberry Street from 3:00pm to 6:00pm on October 13 -15, 2020 and from 12:00pm to 3:00 pm on October 17, 2020 for the MSHSAA Class 2, District 6 Softball Tournament. Councilman Carlson seconded the motion. The motion carried. City Manager Hoon stated he would prepare a Residential Notification for the event.

Councilman Brammer moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Carlson seconded the motion. The motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 1:12 pm.
