

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
October 7, 2015
8:00 p.m.

The Marceline City Council met in special session on October 7, 2015 at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Josh Shoemaker presiding. Council members present were: Jeri Holt, John Carver, Tyson Brammer, and Sallie Buck. Staff attending were: City Manager Richard Hoon, Acting Secretary Kim Othic, and Water and Waste Water Superintendent Kevin Wiggins.


Mayor Josh Shoemaker led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Shoemaker called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. following the public town hall meeting to get public input into the pool design. Three options of pool design were compared and discussed as well as options for handicap access. Mayor Shoemaker stated that all three options were equal in cost and that the preferred design by those attending the town hall meeting was Concept D-3. Questions from the public attending were taken and answered. City Manager Hoon stated that the public must understand that although the design would be chosen, the pool would not go forward until the issue was placed on the ballot and approved. A motion to approve Concept D-3 as the chosen pool design was made by Councilman Carver and seconded by Sallie Buck. The motion was unanimously approved by roll call vote.

A motion was made by Councilman Brammer to go into executive session and seconded by Councilman Carver. A roll call vote carried the motion.

Upon returning to open session there was discussion on complaints made to council members about police officers.

With no further business, Councilman Carver moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 9:50 pm.
