

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
October 8, 2019**

The Marceline City Council met in special session on October 8, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Sallie Buck presiding. Council members present were Jeri Holt, Tyson Brammer, Liz Cupp, and Lacey Meissen. Staff attending: City Attorney William Devoy, City Manager Richard Hoon, City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman, and Police Chief Bob Donelson. Others Present: none.

Mayor Sallie Buck led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order at 11:00 am.

Councilman Brammer moved to adjourn to Executive Session pursuant to RSMo 610.021 Paragraph (3) Personnel and to include guests Police Chief Bob Donelson, Police Captain John Wright, and Desk Officer Rhonda Gulley. Councilwoman Meissen seconded the motion. The motion carried with the following roll call vote: Councilman Brammer – aye, Councilwoman Meissen – aye, Mayor Buck – aye, Councilwoman Cupp – aye, and Councilman Holt.

Council returned from Executive Session at 1:04 pm.

City Manager Hoon reported that the Fire Department is requesting that a vehicle be declared as surplus to be donated to a specific individual. Fire Chief / Councilman Holt explained the reasoning behind the request. City Attorney William Devoy informed the Council that when dealing with City property, it cannot be donated / given away without a benefit to the City, there has to be strings attached. Fire Chief / Councilman Holt reported the individual is willing to donate his time to the City. City Attorney William Devoy stated if a contract is drawn up that shows the value of the vehicle and the individual will do a, b, c than the City will forgive the note it may be possible. City Manager Hoon stated he will work with the City Attorney and the Fire Chief to prepare a surplus ordinance for the vehicle and an agreement specifying the value of the vehicle and specific tasks to be completed in exchange if the Council is agreeable. The Council provided a consensus to move forward.

Councilman Brammer moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 1:10 pm.
