

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
October 30, 2020

The Marceline City Council met in special session on October 30, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Sallie Buck presiding. Council members present were Tyson Brammer, Jeri Holt, Lacey Meissen and Gary Carlson. Staff attending: City Manager Richard Hoon, City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman and Police Chief Bob Donelson. Others Present: none

Mayor Sallie Buck led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Budget Amendment – Bill No. 35-2028: City Clerk Krumpelman explained the budget amendment to the Council. The Council discussed the budget amendment. Councilman Brammer moved that Bill No. 35-2028 to amend the 2019-2020 fiscal year budget be read twice by title only. Councilman Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried. City Clerk Krumpelman read Bill No. 35-2028 twice by title only. Councilman Brammer moved that Bill No. 35-2028 be passed. Councilwoman Meissen seconded the motion. The following roll call vote carried the motion: Councilman Brammer – aye, Councilwoman Meissen – aye, Councilman Holt – aye, Councilman Carlson – aye, and Mayor Buck – aye. This Bill was assigned Ordinance Number 35-2026.

Disc Golf Course: Councilman Holt stated he walked the course and does have concerns with Hole 7. He stated if there are issues after it is installed that the holes could potentially be moved or removed. There was discussion on the topic. Councilwoman Meissen moved for the Recreation and Park Board to move forward with the project with the City reserving the right to move or remove tees and baskets if the City deems it necessary. Councilman Brammer seconded the motion. The motion carried with Mayor Buck voting in the negative.

At 8:15 am Councilman Brammer moved to adjourn to Executive Session pursuant to RSMo 610.021 Paragraph (3) Personnel and to include guest Police Chief Donelson. Councilwoman Meissen seconded the motion. The motion carried with the following roll call vote: Councilman Brammer – aye, Councilwoman Meissen – aye, Councilman Carlson – aye, Councilman Holt – aye, and Mayor Buck – aye.

At 8:24 am Council returned to open session. Councilwoman Meissen moved to convert the desk officer position to a civilian administrative assistant position in the Police Department. Councilman Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried. Police Chief Donelson stated he would like to convert two (2) positions to Sergeant positions with the savings and the promotions would be internal. City Manager Hoon stated there were calculations that needed to be done to verify the savings and would have to be discussed at a later date since Sergeant is not a position included in the Salary and Wage scale.

Councilman Holt moved to adjourn. Councilwoman Meissen seconded the motion. The motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:29 am.
