

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL  
**December 15, 2017**

The Marceline City Council met in special session on December 15, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Jeri Holt presiding. Council members present were: Tyson Brammer, Sallie Buck, and Natalie Wellman. Non in attendance: Liz Cupp. Staff attending: City Manager Richard Hoon, City Administrative Clerk Kasey Milliron, Chief Bob Donelson, Pool Manager Carol Logue, and Water / Wastewater Superintendent Roger Sullivan. Missouri Main Street Team: Keith Winge and Gayla Roten: Also in attendance were: Julie Sheerman and Linn County Leader News Editor Michael Dieringer.

Mayor Jeri Holt led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm.

**BILL No. 17-12.058-SCEAP GRANT- ALLSTATE AGREEMENT AMENDMENT:**

City Manager Hoon stated that the City is still waiting on an extension approval from DNR. Councilwoman Buck moved that Bill No. 17-12.058 be read twice by title only. Councilman Brammer second the motion. City Manager read Bill No. 17-12.058 twice by title only. Councilwoman Buck moved that Bill No. 17-12.058 be approved. Councilman Brammer seconded the motion. The following roll call vote carried the motion: Councilwoman Buck – aye, Councilwoman Wellman – aye, Councilman Brammer – aye, and Mayor Holt – aye. This bill is assigned Ordinance Number 17-12.056.

**Downtown Marceline:**

Missouri Main Street Team: Keith Winge and Gayla Roten presented the Marceline Community Master Plan. They stated that Marceline has so much to offer. There are strategic ways that were discussed. Community needs include things such as Diverse Housing, Food & Entertainment, Creative Arts, Lodging, and Youth Development.

Keith Winge presented and discussed branding and a logo for the City. Branding will help tell the story of Marceline and recognize Walt Disney. The logo will look similar to the existing logo, just updated in appearance. Keith Winge presented “Small Town America. Perfectly Animated”; for the signature on the brand. Councilman Brammer stated he did not like the flag on the brand. Councilwoman Buck asked if it was animated.

Gayla Roten explained that Downtown revitalization takes time. She presented two Ripley Park future layout plans. The plans show active space for the entire Park. The layout plans will need to go to the Park Board first. The final plan will have to be adopted than followed by a resolution.

At 3:48 pm Councilman Brammer moved to adjourn. Councilwoman Wellman seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
