

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
December 30, 2014

The Marceline City Council met in special session on December 30, 2014 at 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Mayor Jacob Gordon, presiding. Council members present were: Jeri Holt, Josh Shoemaker, and John Carver. Councilman Hatfield was absent. Staff attending: City Manager Richard Hoon and City Clerk Lindsay Krumpelman.

Mayor Gordon stated that the OK Tavern will be changing hands to Mike Wrenn. Due to that, a liquor license to reflect the change of owners has been requested. The OK Tavern has a liquor license under the previous owner. City Clerk Krumpelman confirmed that the required paperwork and prorated license fee has been received by City Hall. Councilman Holt moved to approve the liquor license for Mike Wrenn and the OK Tavern and Grill located at 126 E. Howell. Councilman Carver seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

City Manager Richard Hoon provided a brief update on the meetings to be held with Bob Harbour concerning the new electrical contract.

With no further business, Councilman Holt moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Shoemaker seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. The meeting ended at 4:05 p.m.
