## RESIDENTIAL NOTIFICATION

### W. California Water Line Replacement Project – Planned Water Outage

**June 8, 2018**

Beginning on Monday, June 11, 2018, the City Water Department will begin replacement of the problematic water line on W. California Avenue, from Main Street USA to N. Mulberry Street. This project requires a week-long project schedule, with water service being disrupted to specific water customers for a short duration in the week. The project schedule is as follows:

- **5:30 am, Monday, June 11:** Dig at the intersection of W. California Avenue and N. Mulberry Street to expose the work area for valve installation the following day. Crews will continue to excavate east to Chestnut.
- **9:00 am, Tuesday, June 12:** Shut off water service, drain and cut lines and install one valve at the intersection of W. California Avenue and Mulberry Street. This water disruption will affect the following customers during this portion of the project for approximately 3 hours:
  - 300-400 Blocks of W. Ritchie Ave.
  - 200-300 Blocks of N. Mulberry St.
- **Wednesday – Friday (June 13-15):** Daily, between 8:00 am and 3:30 pm, the Water Department will continue excavation and new line insertion all the way to Main Street USA. **There is no water disruption scheduled for this portion of the project.**

NOTE: Following the Independence Day festivities, the project will be completed with valve replacement and connection of the new line to the main line on Main Street USA. A separate notice of water disruption will be posted.

This project schedule is subject to change based on weather and/or discovery of subterranean objects not previously known. During the project, more customers may be identified as being affected. Customers not at the above listed area who experience loss of water service are urged to report it to City Hall at (660) 376-3528. Once water service is restored, another residential notice will be posted notifying residents and businesses of the project completion and water boil notification.

This project is one of many that residents will see the replacement of old water lines in the City in the next 5 years. The schedules are being prepared to minimize the impact to City residents, but may be temporarily inconvenient at times. We urge residents to share this information with their friends and neighbors to ensure widest dissemination.
