RESIDENTIAL NOTIFICATION

Limitations on curbside placement of garbage cans

June 13, 2017

With all the beautification efforts being done by various organizations and citizens, the City has received an increased number of complaints about trash and recycle cans being left curbside on a permanent basis. This notification is being provided as a courtesy for residents to be aware of the City's policy on this matter and help spread the word.



The practice of leaving trash cans at the curb on a permanent basis has an unsightly appearance and is unsanitary and dangerous. It is also a violation of the Marceline Municipal Code Section 230.030 (Collection of Solid Waste); specifically:

“Any solid waste containers, including supplemental containers permitted by this Chapter, will be placed at the curb or alley for collection and shall be placed no earlier than 6:00 pm preceding the collection day. Container must be removed from curb by 11:59 pm on day of collection and placed in the most inconspicuous location as possible, which may include side of residence, garage or porch.”

Continued violation of this policy could potentially result in a citation and subsequent fine.

For elderly residents or those who are physically unable to move the garbage and recycle cans to and from the curb, there is a solution. Advance Disposal provides two types of Walkup services to customers with physical disabilities – temporary and permanent. To apply for Walkup service, please visit City Hall for an application form to be submitted to Advance Disposal by the resident. Physically disabled persons will require physician verification.
