### Water Service Restored / Boil Water Advisory

June 13, 2018

The water line break near the intersection of Mulberry and Santa Fe has been repaired. Due to this unscheduled water disruption, the City of Marceline is using a 48-Hour Boil Water Advisory beginning 3:00 pm, Wednesday, June 13 and ending 3:00 pm, Friday, June 15, 2018 for residents in the area(s) listed below:

- 100–500 Blocks of W. Lake
- 500-700 Blocks of W. Walker
- 100-200 Blocks of S. Poplar
- 100 Block of N. Poplar
- 200-400 Blocks of N. Mulberry
- 300-400 Blocks of W. Ritchie
- HWY JJ to the Sewer Plant
- 300-600 Blocks of W. Santa Fe
- 100-200 Blocks of W. Chicago
- 200 Block of W. Crocker
- 200-300 Blocks of W. Truman
- 500-700 Blocks of N. Chestnut
- 100-400 Blocks of W. Hauser  
(includes Cedarbrook, Allison, and Sunset housing units)

We recommend that you boil your drinking water for 48 hours. It is recommended that drinking water be boiled at a rolling boil for three minutes and that you flush your own system, including the water heater.

The City has begun replacing its aging water lines through a five-year plan approved by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. However, for every two steps forward, these unscheduled disruptions are a step backward in trying to ensure that customers have reliable and clean water. We ask the public to have patience with us as we work toward this end goal.
