## Limitations on Fireworks Discharge June 22, 2022

It is with great pride that we, as citizens of the United States, celebrate our independence every year. With the celebration comes the tradition of fireworks displays, both public and on private property. This Residential Notification is a courtesy reminder of the limitations for the discharge of fireworks in the City limits as provided in the Marceline Code of Ordinances.

The discharge of fireworks is only permitted between July 1<sup>st</sup> and July 4<sup>th</sup> (until 1:00 a.m. on the 5<sup>th</sup>) unless the City Manager or Fire Chief have determined that weather conditions have created a situation where the discharge of fireworks would constitute a fire hazard. The discharging of common fireworks (those purchased in the State of Missouri without a special license) shall be permitted at the following times/dates:

- 10:00 a.m. 11:00 p.m. / July 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup>
- 11:00 a.m. 1:00 a.m. / July 4<sup>th</sup> 5<sup>th</sup>



Further, it shall be unlawful for any person to possess, throw, use, detonate or shoot, within the City limits, any fireworks with an aerial trajectory having a cylinder or cartridge that is not intended to be completely consumed before landing.
