STARTING JULY 12TH

YOUR SERVICE DAY FOR GARBAGE:	WILL STAY THE SAME
YOUR SERVICE DAY FOR RECYCLING:	Every other Tuesday with your first collection on Tuesday, July 12th
BULK WASTE:	Bulk waste will be collected once in May and once in November. Dates to be announced by the City and Advanced Disposal.

RECYCLING COLLECTION WILL BE EVERY OTHER WEEK IN THE PROVIDED 65-GALLON WHEELED CART. YOU MAY BEGIN USING YOUR CART STARTING ON JULY 12th.

There will be no pickup on the following holidays and routes will be delayed by one day following a holiday.

Independence Day – Monday, July 4, 2016. Monday through Friday service will be delayed by one day.

Labor Day – Monday, September 5, 2016. Monday through Friday service will be delayed by one day.

Thanksgiving Day – Thursday, November 24, 2016. Thursday through Friday service will be delayed by one day.

Christmas Day – Sunday, December 25, 2016. No change in service day.

Curbside Garbage Service

- Pickup once per week on Tuesday in provided 95-gallon wheeled cart.
- Garbage must be placed curbside the night before collection day, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Items NOT accepted for pickup include: hazardous waste, liquid waste, tires, animal carcasses, yard waste.

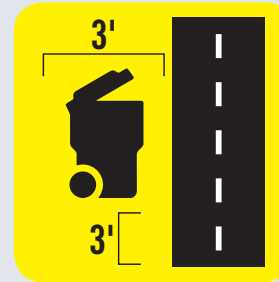
Curbside Recycling Service

- Pickup every other week in provided 65-gallon cart.
- Recyclables must be placed curbside the night before, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Items that do not fit within the cart should be placed in clear bags and set beside the cart with the exception of newspaper and cardboard. Newspaper and cardboard must be broken down, tied, and bundled for collection.
- Items accepted for pickup include: bi-metal and aluminum cans, plastics #1, #2, corrugated cardboard, newsprint and magazines.
- Shredded paper must be bagged to prevent blowing.
- NO GLASS
- NO STYROFOAM
- NO CARDBOARD FOOD CONTAINERS OR PAPER PLATES

Bulk Waste Service

Bulk Waste will be collected once in May and once in November with dates to be determined and announced by the City of Marceline and Advanced Disposal.

- Bulk waste must be placed curbside the night before, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Items NOT accepted for pickup include:
 - Construction and Demolition Debris
 - Tires and Auto Parts
 - Hazardous Material
 - Yard Waste or Vegetation
 - Liquids (cooking oil, chemicals, paint, etc.)
 - Banned Materials By Law



Cart Placement

- Carts should be placed no more than three (3) feet from the curb.
- There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your cart and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes and other carts.
- Be sure to place garbage and recycling carts on opposite sides of the driveway.
- Cart handle should be facing the house and away from the street.

RECYCLE

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Recyclables must be placed curbside the night before, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- All recyclables must be clean of food and other debris.
- Items not clean contaminate the other recyclable items and may not be accepted by Hope Haven for processing.
- Glass and Styrofoam are not approved recyclable items and should be placed in your trash.
- Shredded paper should be bagged to help prevent blowing debris.
- Cardboard and newspapers should be bundled.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Plastics #1 & #2, Aluminum Cans, Steel Cans, Paper, Corrugated Cardboard
