



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

MARCELINE MUNICIPAL POOL REPAINTING PROJECT

The City of Marceline is accepting SEALED proposals for the repainting of the Marceline Municipal Pool in Fall 2026. The city is requesting SEALED proposals for the work listed below:

1. Power Washing and Cleaning of the Pool, specifically an approved chemical wash must be used to clean pool surface.
2. Repainting of the pool with contractor supplied paint that is certified for swimming pools.
3. Repainting of all black lane lines, blue trim around the pool, black depth markers, and other black pool markings.
4. Anti-Skid substance added to stairs and zero-entry area for safety of slipping.
5. Sandblasting prior to painting, if required.

Proposals are to include:

1. Price Proposal for Painting as described in scope of work including labor, paint, and materials.
2. Sandblasting and/or surface repairs price proposal, if contractor believes it is required before painting can be completed.
3. Description of preparation method, proposed coating system, and number of coats.
4. Include the Paint Brand, Paint Brand Name, Type and whether rubber based or epoxy coating.
5. Proposed Schedule of work including, available start date, sandblasting (if required), painting, required drying time, and expected completion time.
6. Warranty
7. References

Bidders are expected to perform a pre-bid site inspection

The Marceline Pool is a 150,000-gallon pool, that is (+/-) approximately 6500 sq. ft.

It is preferred that these repairs are made in Fall 2026 in order for the dome to be installed in a timely manner.

The bidder shall provide the OWNER with a CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE in a form acceptable to City providing coverage for Property Damage in the amount not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, General Commercial Liability in the amount not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, and total aggregate coverage of \$1,000,000.00. The City will be named as an additional insured on the liability insurance. In addition, the bidder shall have proof of workers' compensation insurance in statutory amounts with employer's liability coverage of \$500,000.

If the bid exceeds \$75,000 then Missouri prevailing wage rates will apply. If the bid exceeds \$50,000 then the successful bidder must provide a payment and performance bond for the work. The City is exempt from sales taxes.

Bidders are informed that pursuant to Section 285.530 RSMo as a condition of the award of any contract in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5000), the successful bidder shall, by sworn affidavit and provision of documentation, affirm its enrollment and documentation, affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection to the contracted services. Successful bidders shall also sign an affidavit affirming that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection to the contracted services.

Bidders are informed that the project is subject to the requirements of Section 292.675 RSMo, which requires all contractors or subcontractors doing work on the project to provide, and require its on-site employees to complete, a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations that is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program. If on-site employees had not previously completed such training, the training must be completed within sixty (60) days of the date, work on the project commences. On-site employees found on the worksite without documentation of the required training shall have twenty (20) days to produce such documentation.

The City reserves the right to accept and or reject any or all proposals submitted and to request additional information from any and or all bidders. Furthermore, the proposal selected will be from the bidder which, in the opinion of the Council, submits the bid that best meets the needs of the City. It is not the policy of the City to award a contract on the basis of price alone. The City reserves the right to award the contract to the Proposer offering the best value, and not necessarily to the Proposer offering the lowest price. A Proposal may be evaluated and selected on the basis of references, reputation, experience, past performance, skill, financial capacity, product quality and features, delivery schedule, quality installation, and product service warranty. Sealed proposals will be accepted until **3:00 pm CST, September 11, 2026**.
