

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARCELINE CITY COUNCIL
July 29, 2026

The Marceline City Council met in special session on July 29, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chamber of Marceline City Hall, Mayor Shelly Milford presiding. Council members present were Sallie Buck, Jacob Clay and Brian Baker. Staff attending: City Manager Jesse Wallis and City Clerk/Assistant City Manager (ACM) Lindsay Krumpelman. Others present: Jake Markov, Jami Markov and Doretta Harrison.

Mayor Milford led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Milford called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Councilman Clay moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Gibson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Liquor License Request – J and J Management (116 S Main Street USA): City Clerk / ACM Krumpelman stated the Jami Markov has applied for a “Liquor by the Drink” license on behalf of J and J Management, LLC for J & J On Main restaurant located at 116 S Main Street USA. She stated letters notifying neighbors within 100 feet of the premises that they have applied for a liquor license, are within 100 feet of a church and the meeting date, were sent out on July 15, 2026. City Clerk / ACM Krumpelman stated they are working on obtaining their MO Retail Sales Tax Number and state liquor license. The Council discussed the topic. Councilman Baker moved to approve the liquor license contingent upon payment of the fee, obtaining their retail sales tax number and state liquor license. Councilman Clay seconded the motion. The motion carried.

August Council Meeting Date: Mayor Milford stated two (2) members now have conflicts with the August meeting date. City Clerk / ACM Krumpelman stated the public hearing for the tax levy is August 17th and would prefer a date after the public hearing, otherwise a special meeting will need to be scheduled. The Council discussed the topic. Councilman Baker moved to move the regular August meeting to Thursday, August 20, 2026. Councilman Clay seconded the motion. Th motion carried. City Clerk/ACM Krumpelman inquired if the city staff could apply for grants through Chariton Valley if the deadline is before the August 20th meeting. The Council provided a consensus that they can if they are no-match grants.

With no further business, Councilwoman Buck moved to adjourn. Councilman Clay seconded the motion. The motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 5:40 pm.
